Long-Term Care Services

In our long-term care services, we provide a wide range of assistance to support the lives of our customers in 28 prefectures nationwide, including day care (day services), home-visit care, In-home care support services, rental and sales of assistive equipment, housekeeper referral services, group homes for the elderly, assisted living residences for the elderly, and fee-based residential nursing home services.



Nursing Care Services

We provide home-visit nursing services mainly in Tokyo, Chiba, and Aichi Prefectures.



Childcare Services

We provide services for the operation of authorized childcare centers, small-scale childcare services, and in-company childcare centers.



Disability Welfare Services

We operate comprehensive support services for persons with disabilities and group homes for persons with disabilities in Tokyo, Kanagawa, Chiba, Tochigi, Saitama, and Aichi Prefectures.



Long-Term Care Services

Day Services

We operate three types of day services facilities: "Large-scale type," "Function-focused type," and "Dementia care type."



Rental and Sale of Assistive Equipment

We rent and sell assistive equipment. Our knowledgeable staff will suggest assistive equipment that is suited to the customers' situation and living environment



Home-Visit Care

Home helpers visit customers' homes to provide physical care such as meals, toileting, and bathing, as well as daily living assistance such as cleaning, laundry, shopping, and cooking.



Assisted Living Residence for the Elderly

Unlike typical rental housing, we provide support in terms of both services and facilities to ensure that our customers can live safely and with peace of mind.



In-home care support services

Care managers create plans tailored to each customer's situation and coordinate with service providers and other parties to ensure that customers receive the care services they need.



Fee-Based Residential Nursing Homes

We have a system in place where nurses and care workers provide services 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. This is a nursing home service that provides support to individuals with diverse medical and caregiving needs, helping them live with peace of mind and dignity until the very end, while maintaining their personal way of life.



Group Homes for the Elderly

Although each room is limited in space, we provide daily necessities and furniture that the customers have used throughout their lives so that they can continue living in familiar ways.



Housekeeper Referral

The housekeepers referred by our company will visit your home to provide assistance with daily tasks such as nursing care, cleaning, laundry, cooking, and shopping.






Net Sales




Operating Profit

2024: Awarded the Gold Prize in the "Kawasaki Health and Happiness Project"

In order help school staff deepen their understanding of disability welfare services, we were invited to speak as guest lecturers at a special needs school for children with health impairments, which includes elementary through high school levels. The lectures covered topics such as disability pensions, the classification system, and how to utilize welfare services with a view toward the future.



2025: An agreement was concluded regarding support for people returning home on foot during disasters

We have entered into agreements with the "Nine metropolitan areas, the Union of Kansai Governments, and Aichi Prefecture" to provide tap water, toilet facilities, disaster information, maps provided by municipalities, and other support at our facilities for people returning home on foot in the event of a disaster.
